

**MACOUPIN COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY
2011 SPRING FESTIVAL MAY 28-29**

Please note you have two separate contracts in this envelope. We are inviting you to participate in our Spring festival the same as you did in our Fall 2010 festival on the museum grounds in Carlinville, IL. You may reserve the same space as last year (in May) if you have your reservation in by May 1st. Earliest postmark has preference after May 1st. You supply your own display materials (tables, awnings, etc.) Booth may be set up after noon on Friday. Foods are not allowed without prior approval and must be packaged. Vendors selling foods, or giving out food samples must furnish proof of liability. There is no rain date and the festival will be held regardless of weather. Hours are from 9am to 4pm each day.

The society reserves the rights to deny access to and exclude from its festival, notwithstanding vendor applications, any vendor whose exhibited goods are not in harmony with the purpose of the festival. No Swords or knives with the exception of pocketknives 5" and under. No realistic looking toy guns, or guns that fire projectile. The Society reserves the sole and exclusive right of such determination.

The society cannot be held responsible for any accident, theft, breakage, damage or other loss suffered by the exhibitors and their possessions on the grounds or enroute to or from the festival

You will be checked in at the front driveway and allowed to drive one vehicle onto the grounds to quickly unload then come back to finish your set-up. If you have more than one vehicle please instruct them to wait in the parking area until you return to them. We appreciate your cooperation, as it is a strenuous and trying time on day of the set-up for all of us. We are located two blocks west of Hardees. Cross the railroad tracks, and two blocks north.
